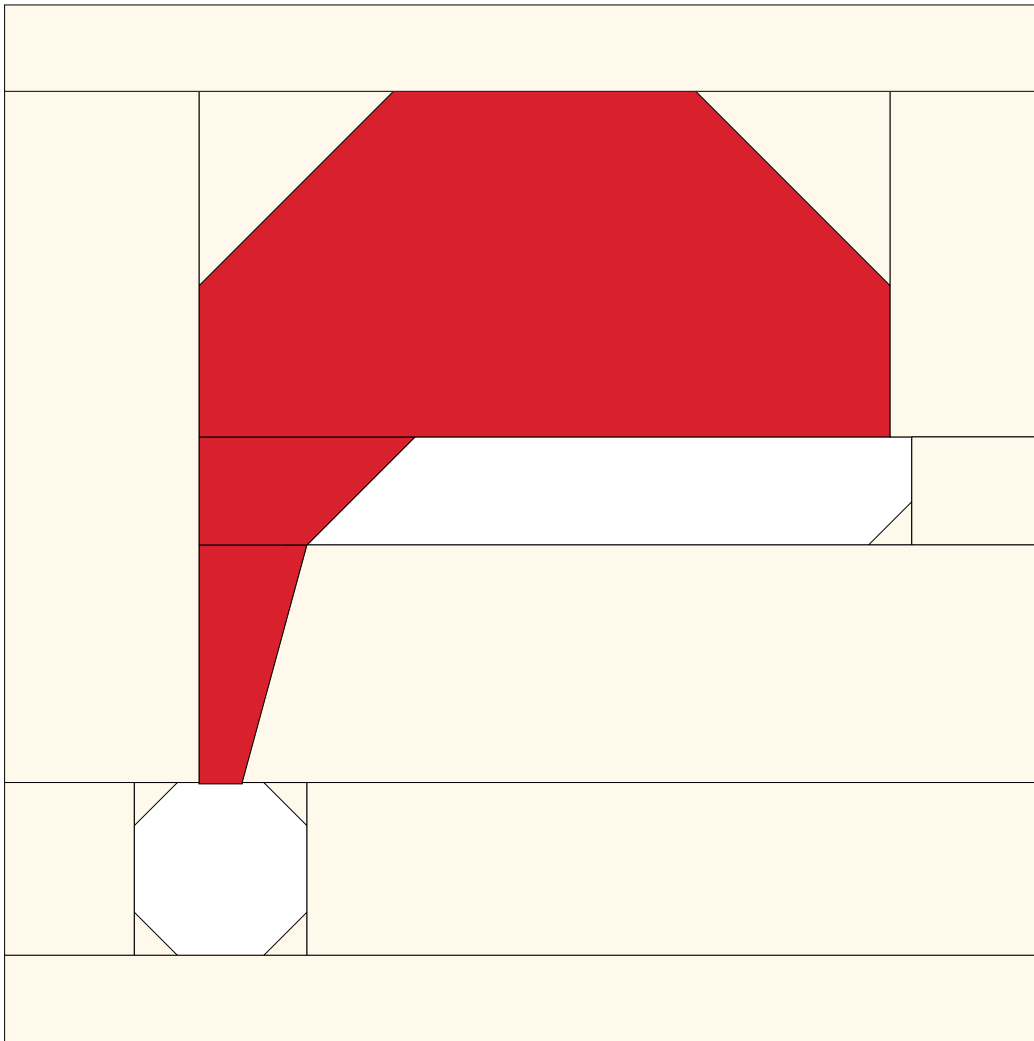

## BEFORE YOU START

- **WOF** = Width of fabric. All pattern measurements assume fabric to be 42" wide from selvage to selvage
- **Seam Allowance** =  $\frac{1}{4}$ "
- Press all seams open unless otherwise stated.

FABRIC	REQUIREMENT
COLOR 1 (HAT)	Fat Quarter
COLOR 2 (TRIM)	Scrap - 2½" x 10"
BACKGROUND	¼ yard or FQ

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

### FROM COLOR 1 (HAT)

**A:** 8½" x 4½"

**B:** 3" x 1¾"

**C:** 1¾" x 3¼"

### FROM COLOR 2 (TRIM)

**D:** 7½" x 1¾"

**E:** 2½" x 2½"

### FROM BACKGROUND

**F:** 2¾" x 2¾" (cut 2)

**G:** 2¼" x 4½"

**H:** 2" x 1¾"

**I:** 9¾" x 3¼"

**J:** 2¾" x 8½"

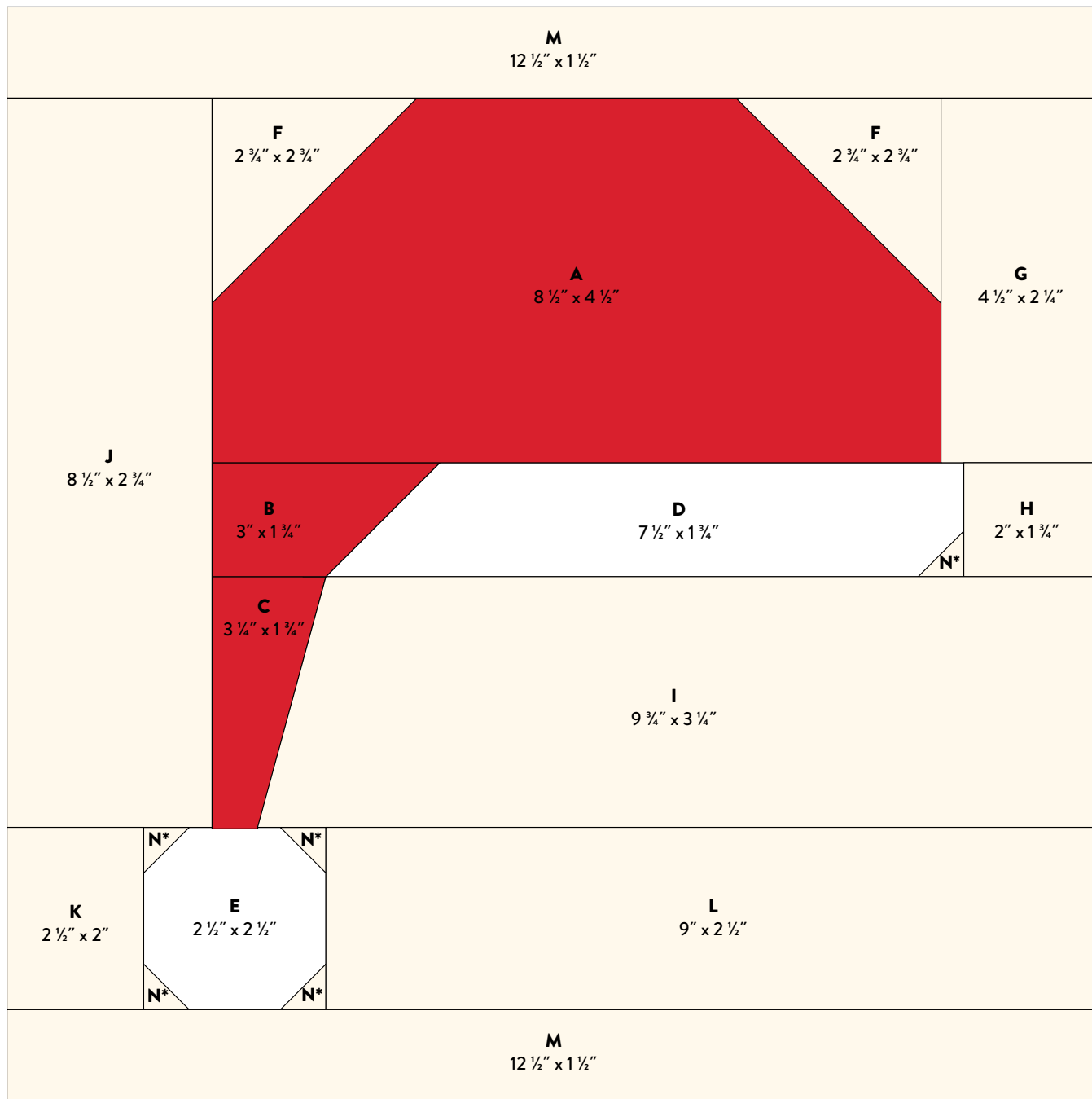
**K:** 2" x 2½"

**L:** 9" x 2½"

**M:** 12½" x 1½" (cut 2)

**N:** 1" x 1" (cut 5)

## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

### HAT - TOP

1. Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the opposite corner on the backside of the Pieces F.
2. Place an Piece F, right sides together, on a corner of the Piece A as seen in **Fig 1**.
3. Sew along the marked line then trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn line. Discard excess. **Fig 2**. Press seam open.
4. Place an Piece F on the adjacent corner of the long end of the Piece A rectangle. Sew on the marked line then trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn line, discard excess. **Fig 3**. Press seam open.
5. Sew Piece G to the right of the unit from Step 4. **Fig 4**. Press seam open or towards Piece G.

### HAT - BRIM

6. Place Piece B on the left corner of Piece D, right sides together. **Fig 5**. On the wrong side of Piece B draw a diagonal line as seen in **Fig 5**.
7. Sew on the marked line then trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn line, discard excess. **Fig 6**. Press seam open.
8. On the wrong side of a Piece N draw a diagonal line. Place Piece N on the bottom right corner of Piece D, right sides together. **Fig 7**
9. Sew on the marked line then trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn line. Discard excess. Press seam open. **Fig 8**
10. Sew Piece H to the right of the unit from Step 9. Press seam towards Piece H. **Fig 9**

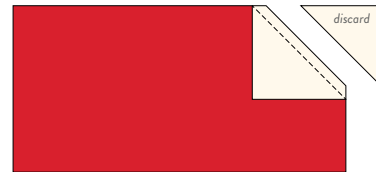

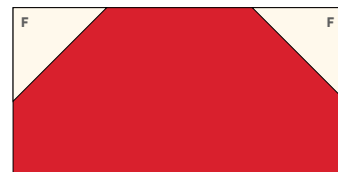

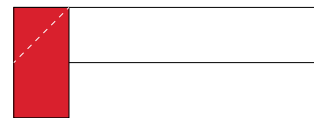

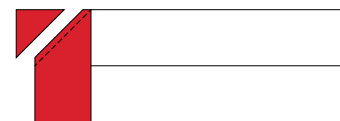

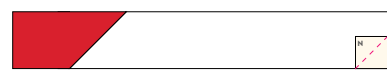

## HAT - DROOP

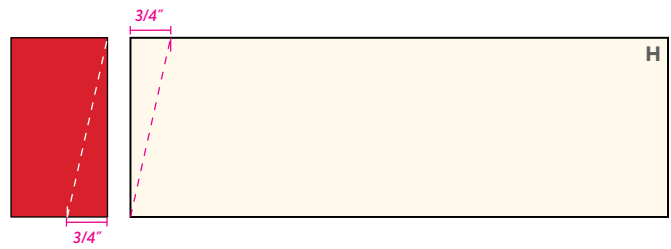


FIG 10 FIG 11

- On Piece C mark  $\frac{3}{4}$ " from the right on the bottom edge and draw a line from the mark to the top right corner. Cut on the line. **Fig 10**
- On Piece I mark  $\frac{3}{4}$ " on the top left and draw a line from the mark to the bottom left corner. Cut on the line. **Fig 11**
- Place pieces right sides together leaving  $\frac{1}{4}$ " overhang. **Fig 12**. Sew. Press seam open.

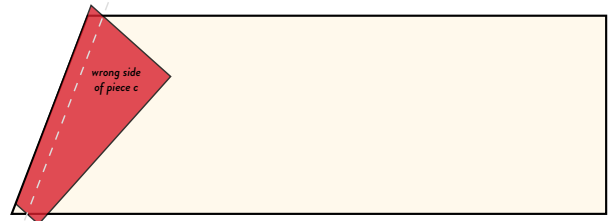

## POM-POM UNIT

- On the wrong side of the remaining Pieces N draw a diagonal line. Place a Piece N in all four corners of Piece E, right sides together. **Fig 13**
- Sew on the marked line then trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn line. Discard excess. **Fig 14**. Press seams open.
- Sew Piece K to the left side of the unit from Step 15, and Piece L to the right side. **Fig 15**

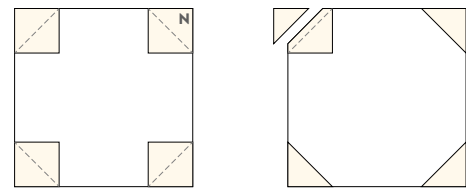

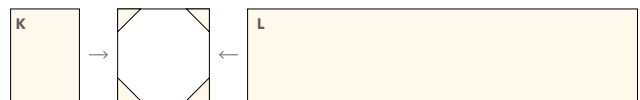

## ASSEMBLE BLOCK

- Sew Hat - Top unit to the Hat - Brim unit, then add the Hat - Droop unit. Press seams open. **Fig 16**
- Sew Piece J to the Unit from Step 17. Press seam towards Piece J. **Fig 17**
- Sew Pom-Pom Unit to the unit from Step 18. Press seam open. **Fig 18**
- Sew a Piece M to the top and bottom of Unit from Step 18. **Fig 19**. Your block will measure  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".

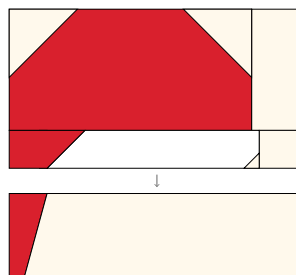
